Purpose and Objectives of PLC

- PLC is a condition under the Environmental Compliance Approval (ECA)
- Function in accordance with the Terms of Reference for the PLC, as amended

“The PLC shall serve as a forum for dissemination, consultation, review and exchange of information regarding the operation of the landfill Site, including environmental monitoring, maintenance, complaint resolution, and new approvals or amendments to existing approvals related to the operation of this landfill Site.”

- PLC members and their roles
- PLC meetings are open to the public and shall be held in public
- The PLC may hear deputations from any member of the public or interested agency pertaining to the Site and its operation

Site Update

Hauling and Leachate Level Update

- From March to end of May, 2,982,000 L of leachate was hauled to an offsite wastewater treatment plant.
- On June 2, the leachate level was measured at 192.8m.

Temporary Measured Exceedance and BRE's Plans to Reduce

- Due to low temperatures and above average snowfall and rainfall this spring, the most recent leachate level measurement taken exceeds the 191m ECA limit.
- The ECA requires BRE to formally notify the Ministry with details of the how BRE plans to reduce the leachate level to below 191m.
- As an immediate action, BRE is increasing raw leachate hauling with a goal to have the leachate level at or below 191 m by the end of June.





Site Update (continued)

Site Improvement

- BRE has retained a local landscape contractor to visually improve the area around main front gate. The work is currently being scheduled with the contractor.

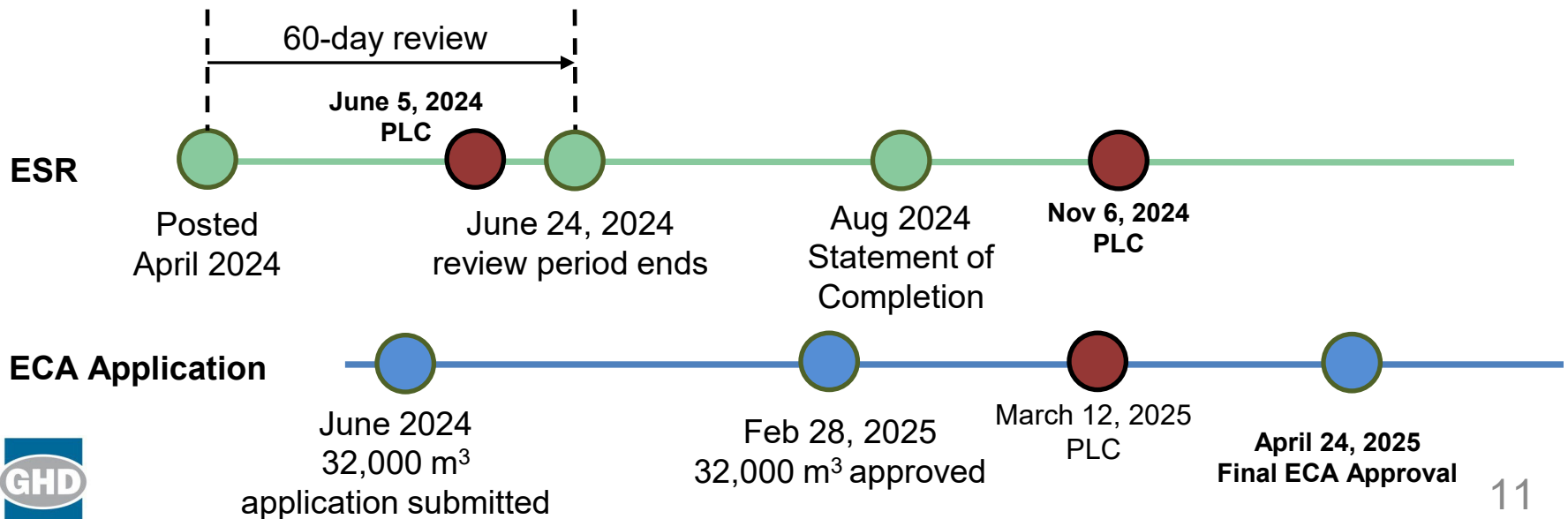
Site Approvals – EA & ECA





Site Approvals – EA (background)

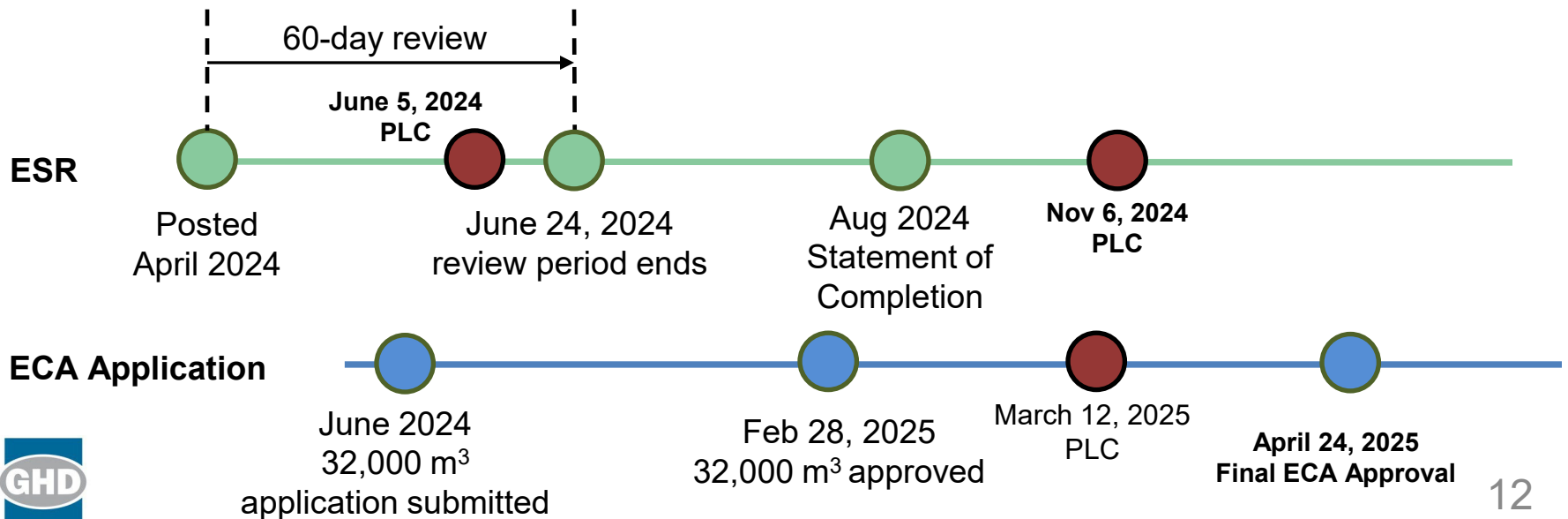
- BRE has completed the Environmental Screening process to add additional capacity by 219,400 m³. The approved footprint is expected to change as a result of the increased capacity.
- The final Environmental Screening Report (ESR) was posted for a 60-day review period from April 2024 to June 24, 2024. Statement of Completion issued in August 2024.
- A Final ECA was received for the full 219,400 m³ capacity on April 24, 2025.





Site Approvals – Expansion Cell

- Design of the expansion cell is completed.
- In fall 2025, due to weather conditions, cell excavation was deferred until spring 2026
- Cell excavation is planned to start in June 2026.

BROOKS ROAD LANDFILL CAPACITY EXPANSION 2022 ENVIRONMENTAL SCREENING

Brooks Road Environmental has completed an [Environmental Screening Process for the proposed capacity expansion of the Brooks Road Landfill](#). The proposed expansion would allow Brooks Road Environmental to respond to the growing demands from waste generators and customers who need a safe and reliable waste management facility for disposal of their post diversion solid non-hazardous industrial, commercial and institutional waste.

The results of the process were documented in an [Environmental Screening Report](#), which is available for a 60-day calendar day review period starting April 25, 2024, and ending on June 24, 2024.
